

Intuit 1099 Issues : Common Problems Business Owners Face and How to Fix Them

Common Intuit 1099 Issues [1-888-493-2290] in QuickBooks

1. Contractors Missing From the 1099 List

One of the most frequent issues is discovering that a vendor or contractor **does not appear on the 1099 list**, even though payments were made.

This usually happens when:

- The vendor is not marked as **1099-eligible**
- The wrong vendor type was selected
- The tax ID information is incomplete
- Payments were recorded to non-1099 accounts (such as credit cards)

Fix:

Verify vendor settings, confirm tax classifications, and ensure payments were recorded correctly.

2. Incorrect 1099 Amounts

Many users report that **1099 totals do not match** their records.

Common causes include:

- Payments posted to the wrong expense accounts
- Credit card payments incorrectly included or excluded
- Refunds or voided checks not reflected properly
- Changes made after the 1099 setup was completed

Fix:

Review expense accounts mapped to 1099s and run vendor payment reports before filing.

3. 1099 Mapping Errors

QuickBooks relies on **account mapping** to determine what payments are included on 1099 forms.

If accounts are mapped incorrectly:

- Legitimate contractor payments may be excluded
- Non-reportable expenses may be included
- Box 1 vs Box 7 amounts may be wrong

Fix:

Confirm account-to-1099 box mapping before generating forms.

4. E-Filing Errors and Submission Failures

Some users experience issues when trying to **e-file 1099s through Intuit**, including:

- System errors during submission
- Rejected filings

- Confirmation emails not received
- Duplicate filings

These errors can cause missed deadlines or require re-submission.

Fix:

Review filing status carefully and keep confirmation records. In some cases, manual filing may be required.

5. IRS Deadline Confusion

Many business owners are unsure of the correct **1099-NEC and 1099-MISC deadlines**, leading to late filings.

Key reminders:

- **1099-NEC** is due to the IRS and recipients by **January 31**
- Late filings can result in IRS penalties

Fix:

Start the 1099 process early and review contractor data well before the deadline.
